### MANDAN CLUB CONFIRMS 2021 LINE-UP OF RODEOS, ACTIVITIES

The Mandan Horse and Saddle Club will hold a series of three family rodeos in 2021. Dates are June 6, July 25 and Aug. 8. The rodeos will be held at Dacotah Centennial Park, Mandan, just off Memorial Highway and 24th Ave SE.

Family rodeos feature competition in four age divisions: beginners, ages 6 and under; peewees, ages 7-9; juniors, ages 10-14; and seniors, ages 15 and over. All age divisions are determined based on age as of Jan. 1.

Events, depending on age division, include calf and steer riding, chute dogging, breakaway roping, tie-down roping, team roping, dummy roping, barrel racing, keyhole race, goat tying and pole bending.

The top three contestants in each event receive a cash payout equal to 75% of entry fees excluding any stock charges. Contestants placing in the top six in events accumulate points. The top five point earners in each age division receive overall prizes. Contestants also accumulate points over the course of the season toward year-end awards.

Event entry fees vary by age division and whether there is a stock charge. Anyone is welcome to compete by paying an annual club membership of \$50 for families and \$30 for individuals.

Online entry for rodeos is required by midnight the Monday prior. All rodeos begin at 9 a.m. and run through mid-afternoon through early evening. Admission for spectators is free.

In addition to the family rodeos, the Mandan Horse and Saddle Club plans to host a National Barrel Horse Association N.D. District 3 competition on Aug. 7 and N.D. High School Rodeo Association sanctioned rodeos on Aug. 21-22.
